Preview of Texas Accountability System 2017 and Beyond (HB 2804)

On Jan. 6, the Texas Education Agency will release a report showing ratings each district and campus might have received for the 2015-16 school year – if a proposed A-F system had been in place – that rates progress in four of five domains.

The domains rated included:

- *Student Achievement*
- *Student Progress*
- *Closing the Gaps*
- *Postsecondary Readiness*

The fifth domain will address Student and Community Engagement and will be defined in the summer of 2017.

The new system, scheduled to be used in August 2018, will also include an overall grade for each district and campus using a complex formula.
